

Superintendent's Parent Liaison Committee Meeting (SPLC) Minutes March 12, 2020 @ 9:00am Palisades High School

IN ATTENDANCE: Cheryl Stevens, Joe Dougherty, Amy Stumpf, Beth Allen, Linda Ivory, Amber Schlosser, Dr. O'Connell and Rich Heffernan

The group visited the Pirate's Pier Cafe for a morning coffee and treat. Discussed the purpose of the program and how it is helpful for students who may be entering the service industry.

Career Pathway Programs: Rich Heffernan talked about our students having the opportunity to take a deeper dive in an area of interest through Pathway Programs. Medical Career Pathway Programs began in 2006. Coursework and college courses are assigned to support the pathway students choose. We offer Pathways in the following areas: medical, global studies, education, design and engineering, business, and the programs offered at the Upper Bucks County Technical School.

Working this year on developing advisory committees for every pathway, combining educational expertise with industry representatives. We will seek the advice of those industry representatives in continuing to help these programs evolve.

The new science wing was presented to the members of SPLC by Rich Heffernan. Approved by the School Board in February, construction will begin in May. He shared the new layout and the schematic. The proposed cost will be approximately \$3.5 million; it will be paid for through district savings.
